

Recycling

Your quick guide to the Food Waste Recycling Scheme in Bournemouth:

- From **3 March 2014**, food waste will be collected separately for composting
- Collections will be made weekly by the same vehicle as your rubbish collection
- You will be able to recycle all cooked and uncooked food including:-
 - ✓ Meat, fish and bones
 - ✓ Fruit & veg
 - ✓ Dairy
 - ✓ Bread, cakes & pastries
 - ✓ Plate scrapings, rice & pasta
 - ✓ Teabags & coffee grounds
 - ✓ Eggshells
- **NOT** included:-
 - ✗ Plastic bags
 - ✗ Recyclable waste (e.g. bottles, cans)
 - ✗ Food packaging
 - ✗ Pet waste
 - ✗ Garden waste
 - ✗ Liquids including oil & fats
 - ✗ Nappies
- Each household will receive two containers for food waste collection – one small kitchen caddy for indoors and a larger container which either fits inside one of the wheelie bins or alongside it
- Compostable liners for your kitchen caddy will be provided by the Council. Newspaper can also be used to line your kitchen caddy
- You can request new rolls of liners from the Council by completing and attaching the address tags which can be found at the end of your current roll of liners.
